The goal of the Heart Hospital of New Mexico is to provide excellence in health care. This was accomplished by utilizing the finest in design, construction, materials and equipment. The two story facility has 55 inpatient beds, 10 day surgery beds, seven emergency room beds, three operating rooms, four cardiac catheterization laboratories and a heart emergency center. It is located on an eight-acre campus with extensive native landscaping. The campus also includes a multi-level parking garage, also built by Bradbury Stamm, which replaces the parking lot previously located on the site.

The complexity of the project, along with its extremely aggressive construction schedule, necessitated a strong partnering between the contractor, architect and owner.
