

Prairie Star/Santa Ana Golf Club Addition

The Santa Ana Golf Club and Windancer Bar and Grill was a fast-track hospitality project designed by Dekker/Perich/Sabatini and Santa Fe architect Neil Carter. This addition/renovation was constructed on time and within budget.

The clubhouse features a spacious pro shop, men's and women's locker rooms, offices, a service shop and shaded portals for eating and resting. The Windancer Bar and Grill has a full service bar, a galley kitchen and magnificent kiva fireplace. Both the clubhouse and the bar and grill have huge picture windows, overlooking the award winning golf course and the majestic Sandia Mountains.

The project also included the redesign of the four-star Prairie Star Restaurant. Guests now enter through a lavish sculpture garden courtyard and are greeted by a new entry and reception area. The entire addition and renovation continues the southwestern motif established by the original 100-year old rambling hacienda. The interiors were designed to create an old Southwestern feel to the spaces. Typical finishes include rough sawn lumber for ceilings, plastered walls, brick portals and copper tabletops.
