

Torrance County Detention Center

This facility consists of eight new buildings plus two attached to the existing facility. The buildings consist of two buildings housing inmates, a new administration building, new kitchen facility, new medical facility, new gymnasium, new electrical facility, to house 642 additional inmate beds. A waste water pumping facility and new waste water lagoon was also included in this design. The buildings are made of pre-cast concrete and a state of the art security system.

The fully automatic lock in doors and a complete surveillance system maintaining the entire facility inside and out connects the existing facility to the new one.

This project was constructed on a fast-track, nine-month schedule. Crews worked within strict timeline and security constraints since the new buildings tied into the existing prison facilities. Bradbury Stamm completed the project ahead of schedule.

Bradbury Stamm built Phase I of the prison in 1990.
